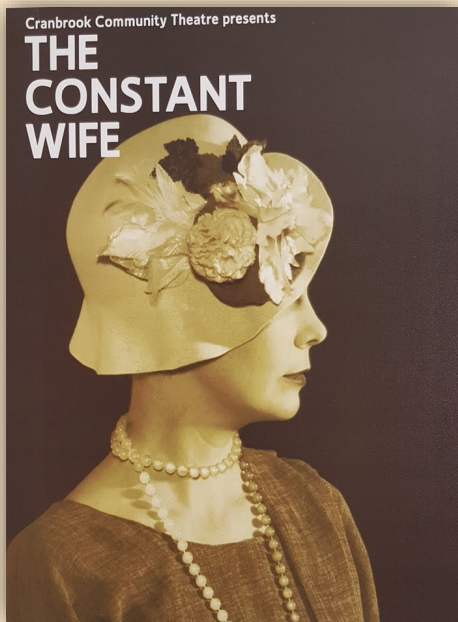
The Constant Wife
